

# Sockyarn Baby Hat

an  
easy peasy  
project



A super duper easy baby hat using any typical sock yarn. Because of it's washability, this little hat is the perfect gift for a new baby.

## Materials:

About 25 grams of sock yarn (superwash wool blended with nylon or similar)  
2.5mm- 3.0mm dpns or circular needles to obtain gauge  
Embroidery needle or small crochet hook for binding in ends

Gauge:  
28 st. to 4" or 10 cm in stockinette stitch

Sizing: baby appx. 3-6 months

## Pattern

CO 112 sts using longtail cast on.

- Join in round, (k3, p1) around for 10 rounds
- Knit following 22 rounds
- Decrease as follows:

Separate stitches into four equal sections either using four needles, or placing markers every 28 sts.

1. (k1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1)  
four times
2. k

Repeat 1 and 2 until you have 4 sts in each section (16 sts total)

(ssk, k2tog) four times

- **Ichord:** Now that you are down to 8 sts total, k around for 7 rounds. Snip yarn with a long tail, and run through the remaining stitches. Pull yarn tail through to wrong side, and fasten.
